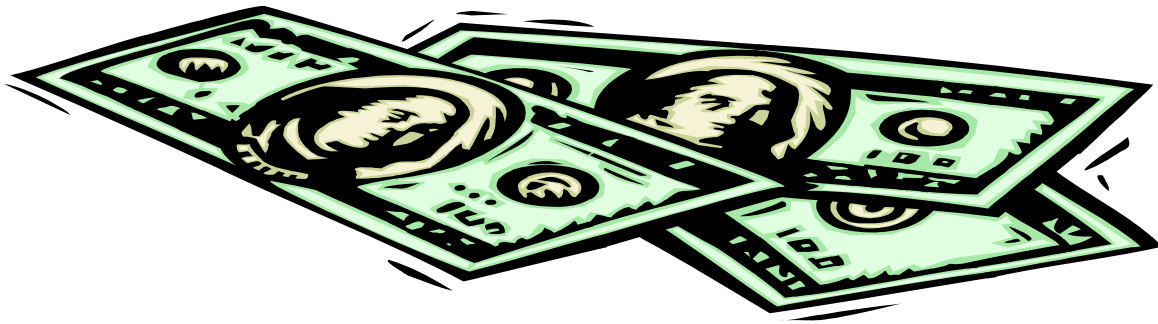

Swimming Pool Manager

Description: Oversee the operation of a Park Swimming Pool with staff of approx. 25 employees. Technical and supervisory duties, scheduling, programming, etc.

Requirements: Swimming Pool Operators Certification, Lifeguard Certification, CPR, 1st Aid and AED Min. 4 years experience in swimming pool operation

Minimum Age: 21 years

Hourly Rate: \$10.85

Swimming Pool Operator

Description: Oversee the operation of a Walk to Pool. Technical and supervisory duties, staff scheduling, programming etc.

Requirements: Pool Operators Certification, Lifeguard Certification, CPR, 1st Aid and AED.

Minimum Age: 17 years

Hourly Rate: \$9.00

Water Safety Instructor

Description: Conduct water safety courses at the municipal swimming pools. Perform lifeguard duties and related duties as required.

Requirements: Water Safety Instructors cert., Lifeguard Certification, CPR, 1st Aid and AED

Minimum Age: 17 years

Hourly Rate: \$8.40

Lifeguard I

Description: Monitors activities of patrons/swimmers at a municipal swimming pool to prevent accidents and provide needed assistance. Maintain order and cleanliness in the pool area.

Perform related duties as required. May be moved as needed.

Requirements: Lifeguard Certification, CPR, 1st Aid and AED

Minimum Age: 15 years

Hourly Rate: \$7.35

Recreation Activities Assistant

Description: Monitors activities of patrons at Municipal swimming pools. Clean and/or supervise the cleaning of common area of public pools. Provide assistance/support to Pool Operator/Manager at entrance, in locker room etc.

Requirements: First Aid and CPR

Minimum Age: 21 years

Hourly Rate: \$7.90

Cashier

Description: Revenue collection at Municipal swimming pools, record keeping. Perform related duties as required. May be moved as needed.

Requirements: Experience as a cashier or willingness to be trained.

Minimum Age: 21 years

Hourly Rate: \$7.75

Swimming Pool Attendant

Description: Monitors entrance/locker room of Municipal swimming pools. Maintain order and cleanliness in and around the pool area. Perform related duties as required.

Requirements: First Aid and CPR

Minimum Age: 14 years

Hourly Rate: \$6.55
